



Audio Producer for a panel discussion series

A joint project between the UTS Indigenous Land & Justice Research Hub and 2SER 107.3, this 10-episode audio series will examine and challenge mainstream media discourse around Aboriginal media aspirations by interrogating existing coverage and narratives and considering their impact on political context.

The Audio Producer will work with a small team to develop and produce series content, with duties to include content planning, research, coordination, scripting, audio recording, editing and digital publishing.

This is an excellent opportunity for a medium-level audio producer to develop experience and skills in a meaningful project setting. The series will be broadcast on 2SER 107.3 and released online as a podcast.

It's a casual role with production hours to be negotiated. Applications close 23:59 AEST Sunday 8 August.

Skills required:

- Excellent digital media literacy, with the ability to learn new software and platforms
- Medium-level audio production skills, including some multitrack editing experience and packaging of talk content.
- Sound editorial skills including the ability to source and analyse information and exercise sound judgement
- High level interpersonal and written communication skills
- Excellent time management with the ability to deliver under tight deadlines

You will have:

- Good time management and ability to work independently for long periods
- Availability for evening or weekend work between August and October 2021.
- The passion to source and create authentic content
- A keen interest in the forces that shape media representation, identity, public discourse and policy
- An understanding of the issues affecting Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples
- An ability to communicate sensitively and effectively with Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander people
